Types of Credit

Graduate Credit

Available through Baker University for \$70 a credit hour
There is additional coursework and project completion.

Professional Development Points

Option 1 - Attendance Points

Attend the workshop/training and receive credit based upon the number of hours completed. Attendance documentation will be submitted.

Option 2 - Graduate Level Points

Attend the workshop/training AND complete additional coursework and project completion (coursework is the same as taking it for graduate credit). 1 graduate credit = 20 PD points.
